Bunny is the author of eight design books—her latest, "Bunny Williams: Life in the Garden," is newly out from Rizzoli—and is a sought-after speaker and mentor on decoration, gardening and entertaining. Her business, Bunny Williams Inc., includes Williams Lawrence, the interior design business she runs with her business partner, Elizabeth Lawrence; Bunny Williams Home, the firm's line of furnishings, lighting, art and accessories; and licensed product lines with Ballard Designs, Lee Jofa, Dash & Albert, Currey & Company, and Mirror Home.






CHARLES STICK


Charles J. Stick is a Charlottesville-based landscape architect celebrated for creating classical gardens. Charles attended undergrad at Middlebury College and received his MLA degree at the University of Virginia School of Architecture. He trained with Dan Kiley and Jaquelin Robertson as a graduate student and later joined international design firm François Goffinet Limited as a senior design architect. In 1994, Charles opened his own office, focusing on residential landscapes that harmonize house and garden. Recipient of the Arthur Ross Award for "Excellence in the Classical Tradition," Charles' life and work are documented in "Charles J. Stick and His Gardens" (Monacelli Press).
